

Information for children in Mrs Nicholson's reception class and Miss Illingworth's class.

Staffing from January 2021

As you will be aware, Miss Illingworth is due to go on maternity leave shortly. Due to the current government guidance, Miss Illingworth will be working from home from the 23rd November. Miss Illingworth will be continuing with online teaching from home and can still be reached by email until her maternity cover officially starts (school will keep parents of Miss Illingworth's class informed).

Mrs Nicholson's class are currently being taught by Mrs Rodenby and was due to go back into teach the reception class once our new Headteacher, Mrs Peach, arrives in January.

As a school, we have thought very carefully about the continuity for both classes and about the educational impact current circumstances are having on the wellbeing and education of our children.

The school have therefore made the decision that Mrs Nicholson will teach in the year 5 / 6 class from January (a separate letter regarding the arrangements for the rest of this term will be sent separately). Mrs Nicholson has recent experience of working in key stage 2 and this would provide continuity for children in their final year at primary school.

Mrs Rodenby will continue to teach Mrs Nicholson's class for the rest of the academic year and Mrs Nicholson will continue to have an overview of the education in early years as the Key stage 1 / early years lead.
