Dear parents/carers

Thank you so much for engaging so positively with home learning. Most parents have either accessed on-line learning or collected a work pack to be completed at home. A huge thank you to staff for working tirelessly to make sure that home learning gets off to a good start for all.

EYFS and Key Stage 1 have had difficulty posting work on Tapestry today and if this continues they will upload their work to the web-site as they did before in the previous Lockdown.

We have approximately 90 children in school at the moment which is far higher than the previous Lockdown. Please be aware that the DfE updated its guidance for critical workers on Friday, advising parents to keep children off school if at all possible. The DfE guidance now states:

'Parents whose work is critical to the coronavirus and EU transition response include those who work in health and social care and in other key sectors. Children with at least one parent or carer who is a critical worker can go to school if required, but parents and carers should keep their children at home if they can'.

If your child is currently attending school and you can work from home, please let us know that a place is no longer needed, so that we can organise staffing accordingly.

We will keep you updated if the Government advice changes.
